Kids of all ages love bubbles! Mix up this Giant Bubble solution for lots of outdoor fun.

Giant Bubble Solution

1 cup of liquid dish soap, Lemon Dawn or Lemon Joy works best.

3-4 tablespoons of glycerine, check for it in your local pharmacy

10 cups of water, soft or distilled water works best.

Gently mix all ingredients together in a large container and then have fun make bubbles with your favorite bubble wand.

Try using straws or the plastic rings for six-pack beverage holders, as bubble wands. You can also make your own using straws and string or wire coat hangers.
